## PERENNIAL VINES


-  **Boston ivy ‘Green Showers’**  
 A clinging vine that will attach to brick or wood. Extra large green leaves, turn a brilliant burgundy in Fall. Vines grow up to 30’.


-  **Chocolate Vine (Akebia quinata)**  
Dark green lacy foliage is purple tinged in winter. Bears edible 3-4” purple fruit. Vines grow up to 30’.

-  **Climbing Hydrangea (anomala petiolaris)**  
 Vigorous vine with clusters of fragrant, white flowers in June & July.  
Excellent for covering a fence. Vines can grow up to 75’.

-  **Honeysuckle (Lonicera Major Wheeler)**  
Red flowers all summer. Mildew resistant. Attracts hummingbirds and butterflies. Vines grow up to 15’.

-  **Honeysuckle (Lonicera Goldflame)**  
 Pink and yellow flowers all summer. Attracts hummingbirds and butterflies.  
Vines grow up to 15’.

-  **Trumpet Vine (Campsis Flava)**  
Fast growing vine for covering fences and arbors. Yellow tubular flowers attract hummingbirds and butterflies. Have patience, they are slow to emerge in Spring. Vines grow up to 25-30’.

-  **Trumpet vine (Campsis Madame Galen)**  
Fast growing vine for covering fences and arbors. Salmon-red tubular flowers attract hummingbirds and butterflies. Have patience, they are slow to emerge in Spring. Vines grow up to 15-30’.

### Clematis

Provide full sun unless otherwise noted.

Keep roots shaded by planting other plants at the base.

Anna-Louise	violet-red flowers in May-June and Aug-Sept
Clair de Lune	white/pale lilac flowers in June-July and late Aug. <b>Prefers shade.</b>
Jackmanii	deep purple flowers in June-July and Sept. The most profuse bloomer.
Josephine	pink/lilac flowers from June-Aug. Unusual shaped flowers.
Moonfleet	7” lilac/blue flowers from June-Aug. <b>New in 2011.</b>
Nelly Moser	pink and white flowers in June and Sept. <b>Will grow in semi shade.</b>
Rhapsody	sapphire blue flowers from July-Sept. Compact growth.
Rouge Cardinal	velvet crimson flowers from June-Sept.
Star of India	violet purple flowers from June-Sept.
Paniculata	small white flowers from Aug-Sept. Very fragrant.
